Make It Work

- **Complement your skintone** Lighter greens are best with either fair or dark skin, while olive is good on medium complexions, says celebrity manicurist Jin Soon Choi. Deep, dark shades flatter everyone.
- **Keep your nail shape soft** With edgier colors, a round shape or a squared-off oval looks best.
- **Try some shimmer** If you want a tamer take on the trend, opt for a polish with a bit of sparkle (like the Butter London and Chanel ones shown here). It gives a lighter look than shimmer-free formulas.
